Nuala Moore is a swimmer to the extremes both in Marathon and in Ice. Her swimming adventures have brought her to the most extreme Ocean locations in the world. She was part of a team to swim around the Island of Ireland-56 days of sheer Atlantic challenge without wetsuits and in 2013 she was part of a team to swim across the treacherous Bering Straits working with Russian Military. She now swims up to 25 mins at 0 degrees and is very experienced at swimming in extreme water and ice.
